

What is an adjective?

Adjectives are words that modify or describe nouns or pronouns by providing information about characteristics, qualities, and attributes. Adjectives can indicate size, colour, shape, texture, sound, smell, taste or any abstract quality. They are an essential part of language, empowering us to create more precise and vivid descriptions of the world around us. In short, adjectives can be describing words for a person, a place or anything under the sun. Several adjectives examples include:

- The happy dog wagged its tail. (happy describes the dog)
- She wore a pretty dress to the party. (pretty describes the dress)
- The tall building stood out in the skyline. (tall describes the building)
- The spicy curry made my mouth burn. (spicy describes the curry)
