

INTENSIVE PRONOUN

Intensive pronouns are a grammatical category of pronouns that bear a striking resemblance to reflexive pronouns. These pronouns, which terminate in “self” or “selves,” play a unique role in emphasizing the antecedent by referring back to another noun or pronoun used earlier in the sentence.
