


## **MODIFIER**

English grammar includes the use of modifiers, which are words or phrases that describe or explain anything else in the sentence. Adjectives and adverbs are words that modify the meaning of other words by providing more information about them, such as their size, color, time, location, manner, or degree. Sentence structure and comprehension depend on the precise, qualified, and limited meanings added by modifiers to the words they modify. Modifiers used effectively may make sentences more precise and vivid, which in turn increases their readability and comprehension.


