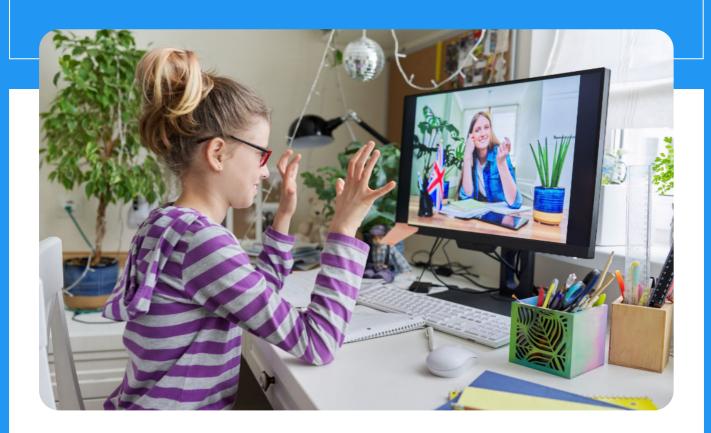


MASCULINE

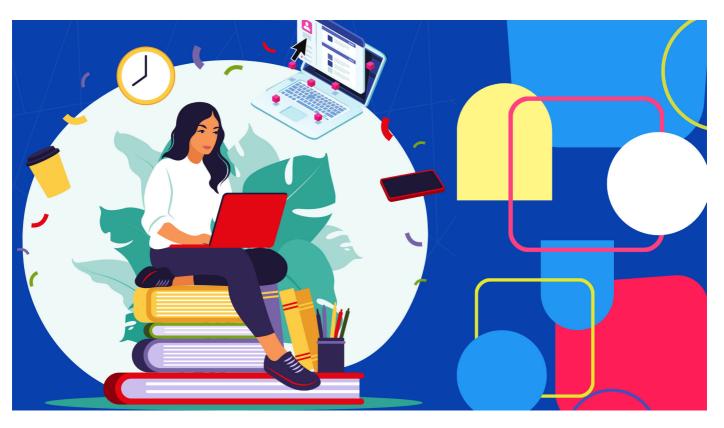
