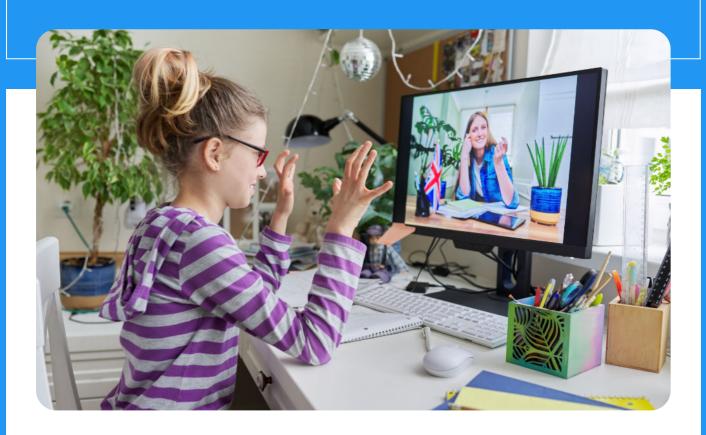


PASSIVE VOICE


