


REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

There are three main reflexive pronouns: myself, yourself, and itself. These can be a little confusing since they have different meanings according to their usage. Reflexive pronouns are words that reflect back on themselves. When you use reflexive pronouns, you should use them correctly. Refer to the below points.


