


SIMPLE PRESENT TENSE

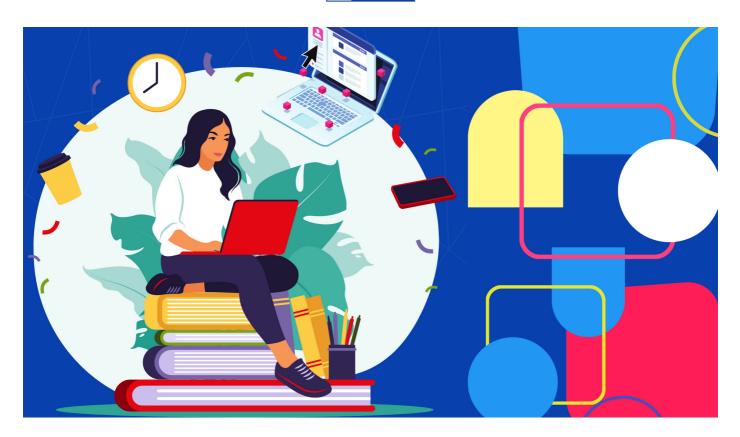
